STEP 1. Write Your Text

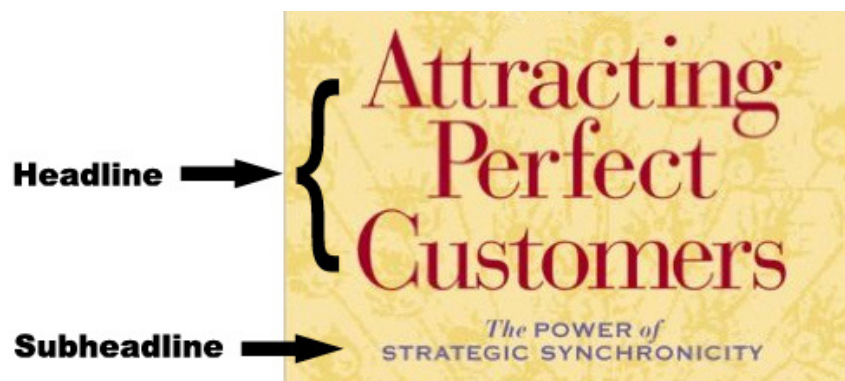
- ❑ Don't double space after a period. It's no longer necessary to follow old rules you may have learned at the typewriter because fonts created for computers take visual spacing into account.
- ❑ Do add a footer to each page: include your website address, your name and contact information.

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STEP 2. Add Your Headlines & Subheads

- ❑ Write one headline after another: it's called a brain dump. Don't worry — the time spent won't be wasted because you'll likely come up with a few great headlines you can use on social media to promote your free offer. TIP: You'll also find headline pearls inside the text you've just written!
- ❑ Try to get your headlines down to 3 words or less if possible: short and snappy is always best.
- ❑ Use lots of subheads because people scan pages full of text. Your sub-headlines should be able to tell your story by highlighting the significant points.



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STEP 3: Choose Your Images

- Search for royalty-free images for your cover and inside pages. My favorites are [Bigstock](#), [iStock](#), and [AdobeStock](#)
- When searching for cover images, choose 4–5 that have great cover potential.
- Try before you buy. Online stock photo companies allow you to download a complimentary, low resolution version of your favorite image. They're called 'comps.' Download a comp and place it into your document to see if it works with your message, before you click the 'buy' button.

STEP 4: Add a Bio & Current Headshot

- Write a short, 1-2 paragraph bio and place it at the end of your document.
- Include a current headshot.

STEP 5: Create a PDF

- Create a PDF file that can be download from your WordPress website.
- Print out a hard copy and read it aloud for comprehension: reading aloud also helps find word usage errors.

TIP: Read it to an 8-year-old because if they don't understand it, chances are no one else will, either. If you don't have an 8-year-old, borrow one.

What's Next?

Most of my clients complete steps 1 through 5 and then panic. They're not alone. The tough part for most people is:

- getting their free offer to look professional,
- setting up a WordPress website,
- setting up their webforms, and
- getting their webforms and free offer onto their WordPress website so they can start to build their list of lucrative, loyal, raving fans.

STEP 6: Setup a WordPress website

STEP 7: Make your free offer look professional

STEP 8: Design an eye popping cover

STEP 9: Render your eye popping cover in 3-D

STEP 10: Setup an email web-host
